## This is how it works:

### Setup the eBill function::

1. Register with SIX Paynet AG.
2. Submit a sample invoice to SIX Paynet AG to verify all the correct information is displayed on your invoices.
3. Inform your customers that your invoices are now also payable with eBill – on [ebill.ch](http://ebill.ch) you are automatically listed as the biller.
4. Log on to the SIX Paynet AG portal.

### How to send an eBill:

1. Create the invoice as a PDF.
2. Log on to the SIX Paynet AG portal.
3. Upload the invoices either individually or as a ZIP file.
4. Using the CAMT file, reconcile the paid invoices with your ERP system.
