Accolades for LLB Annual Report

Best bank in BILANZ rating, Red Dot Award, GRI label

Vaduz, 16 September 2016. Once again, the Annual Report 2015 of the LLB Group achieved excellent marks in the Annual Report Rating of the business magazine BILANZ. The LLB Annual Report also won the international design competition Red Dot in the category Communication Design. And as the first company in Liechtenstein, the LLB has received the label of the Global Reporting Initiative for its sustainability report.

The Annual Report 2015 of the LLB Group is once again one of the twelve best in Switzerland and Liechtenstein. In the category Value Reporting, the LLB ranked 12th after companies like Swisscom, Swiss Re, Sulzer, and Geberit. Design Print and Online reached an excellent 16th place. More than forty specialists in three juries analysed and evaluated the annual reporting of 228 companies in five categories. "

Annual reports are the underrated display windows of the companies," writes the Swiss business magazine BILANZ on the occasion of this year's Annual Report Rating. In 2016, the Annual Report Rating was carried out for the 27th time. It is the only European rating that systematically evaluates both the print and online versions of an annual report.

One of the winners of the Red Dot Award

The Annual Report 2015 of the LLB Group is also one of the winners of the international design competition Red Dot. In the category Communication Design 2016, it was awarded "Best of the Best" for outstanding design. The quality seal Red Dot stands for high design quality worldwide. A jury composed of 26 industry experts evaluated numerous communication and design projects from 46 countries. Only 0.8% were awarded "Best of the Best". "The communication designer of today has become a moderator between the worlds of language, business, and technology, and thus an engine of progress," said Professor Dr. Peter Zec, initiator and CEO of Red Dot, in a press release. The award ceremony takes place on 4 November 2016 at the Konzerthaus in Berlin.
